

Inpatient Hospital Pharmacy Design - Case Study

The client:

A SouthEast Ontario inpatient pharmacy filling strip packaged, blister packed, and traditional medications for a 250 bed facility.

The facility:

- 1,700 square feet
- PacMed unit dose strip packaging machine
- 5 pharmacy technicians
- 1 staff pharmacist
- 1 pharmacy manager
- 1 clerical

The challenge:

Relocate the pharmacy to a new 750 square foot space (66% smaller than existing) with no change in stock levels, staffing, beds or workload.

The new pharmacy:

By making full use of vertical space and incorporating Uniweb's high-density shelving and modular work counters (with flexible under-counter accessories), the pharmacy was successfully relocated to a space 44% the size of the original with no change in staffing levels, workload or storage needs.
